We had called on child specialists and psychologists to share their views on this important topic. The crux that came out, from the event, was that adolescent conflict is a never-ending problem. It came out that conflict is an inevitable part of any relationship. Sometimes the adolescent's conflicts occur due to confusions and it arises due to



immaturity. Conflicts arise due to many factors. Children, like adults, also deal with many problems. What we, as parents forget is that sometimes we treat them as adult, while at the next moment like little kids. In order to avoid these conflicts and confusions, adolescents whose parents give them proper guidance, upkeep and clean atmosphere engage in fewer conflicts. Open communication within the family shows adolescents that happy discussion is the best way to avoid a conflict.
